Silent Panic Alarms in Oregon HB 5014: Budget Summary

As part of its budget-making process, the Oregon Legislature allocates funding for the Department of Education and specific education initiatives. This year's budget, HB 5014, provides targeted funding for school panic alarm systems.





\$2.5 Million for Panic Alarms

The Oregon budget includes a one-time \$2,500,000 General Fund increase appropriated for a grant program to support school districts that install electronic panic alert systems. From this appropriation, the Department of Education may spend up to \$350,000 on integrating panic systems with 9-1-1 emergency systems.

Grant Funds for Oregon Schools

The Department of Education may award one-time grants to school districts of up to \$2,000 per school building to assist with purchase and installation costs.
