What makes a panic alert solution effective?

- All staff must be equipped to use it
- All staff must adopt it
- All staff must be able to use it under duress

Connection Sources & Campus-Wide Coverage

Effective school safety tools should:

- Operate on networks independent of Wi-Fi or cellular data
- Provide total campus-wide coverage, including exterior locations

Immediate & Multi-Layered Notification

Your safety platform should:

- Enable staff to **immediately** and discreetly request assistance
- Allow emergency protocols to be **instantly** initiated anywhere on campus
- Use **multimodal communications** (colored strobe lights, desktop alerts, intercom integration) to immediately notify key stakeholders

Precise Alert Location & Asset Mapping

When first responders don't have exact location information of an emergency, **response times can increase substantially.**

Purpose-built technology should:

- Incorporate campus maps and building floor plans
- Display critical safety assets and evacuation routes
- Provide the floor level and classroom number or exact exterior location of an emergency
