The Challenge

- Prior to May 2022, Little Rock School District was utilizing a mobile phone-based safety app for staff to report emergencies.
- Staff didn't want to put work-related technology on their personal devices.
- Only 20% of employees downloaded the app; even fewer were using it.

The Solution

- The district quickly realized how different CrisisAlert[™] was from other safety technology tools—the wearable was accessible, easy to use, and already trusted by educators.
- In 2022, CrisisAlert was implemented in the district.
