Strobes for Visual Notification and Incident Location Accuracy	Strobes provide floor- and room-level alert locations displayed on digital campus maps	Minimal or no strobes; Can't provide precise alert location info	Flashing strobes in every room, hallway, and common area provide an immediate visual cue a Lockdown has been initiated. Responders receive precise real-time location information of the alert and nearby safety assets to accelerate their response.
Additional Notifications	Yes	No	Intercom announcements and computer screen takeovers provide immediate additional audio and visual notifications of a Lockdown and Lockdown protocols.

Battery Life/Charging Required	Battery lasts for one year+ and does not require charging	Requires charging	A device that must be recharged—whether daily or monthly—is vulnerable to being powerless or connected to its charging device and not accessible when needed.
